4. Learn about certification requirements and scoring procedures.
5. Review content material in an informal environment utilizing a “testing” format including an opportunity for discussion.

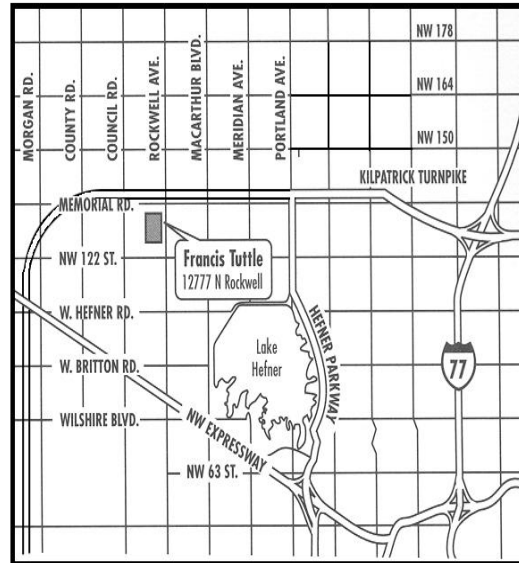
